Staff Donations to Wear Jeans/campus t-shirts, etc.	Determine amount and length of time			
Power of Change	Place one jar per grade level in a highly visible area (main hallway, lunch room, etc.). Students add their spare change to the jars until full. The first grade to fill their jar gets a reward.			
Show Your Character	Allow students to donate to dress as their favorite character (within dress code). This could be an option near Homecoming or Halloween (October 28th).			
Staff/Student Charity Concert/Performances	Round up staff/other students for a musical concert for the students! Sell tickets to watch the teachers perform songs – either as a big group or in small groups. Alternative idea: Ask for teacher/student volunteer performers. Students could vote by donating pennies to jars set up for each volunteer. The winners could give performances during lunches.			
Staff Charity Game	Generate excitement among the students about attending a special sports game that has teams made up of staff! Sell tickets to watch the game, and consider having a concession stand. It could be a serious game or something comical.			
Principal Challenge	Get your campus leaders on board to complete a challenge if a fundraising goal is met. Students can vote for their favorite administrator and favorite challenge by donating or simply donate to reach the fundraising goal as soon as possible.			
Dessert Auction	Have people make desserts and auction them off at Easter, Thanksgiving, Christmas time.
