Advocacy

The American Cancer Society Cancer Action Network (ACS CAN) is making cancer a top priority for public officials and candidates at the federal, state, and local levels.



Reduce barriers

This year ACS CAN will advocate to maintain funding of \$550,000 for the state breast and cervical cancer screening and treatment program for low-income uninsured and underinsured women.

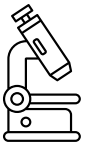


Reduce disparities

In 2023, ACS CAN will work to increase funding for statewide tobacco prevention and cessation programs at \$9 million. They will advocate for all insurance plans, including Medicaid, to provide a comprehensive cessation benefit that covers all FDA-approved tobacco cessation medications.

Research Grants

Since 1991, we have invested \$3.1 billion in cancer research nationwide contributing to 3.5 million fewer cancer deaths.

Patient Support

Providing support programs like 24/7 cancer helpline, rides to treatment, lodging during treatment, online survivor support platform, 1:1 breast cancer support, and hair loss and mastectomy products for people with cancer and their caregivers.



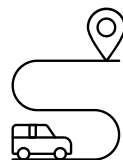
