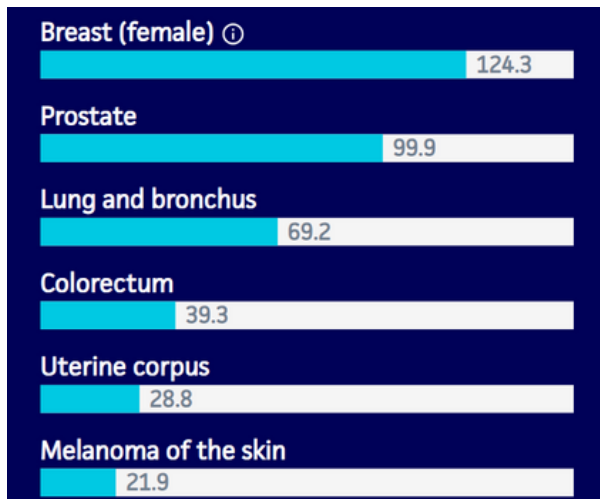

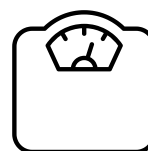

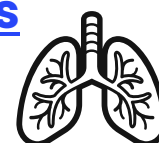
Only 60% of girls and 47% of boys aged 13-17 in Indiana are vaccinated against HPV. Indiana is among the worst in the nation.
