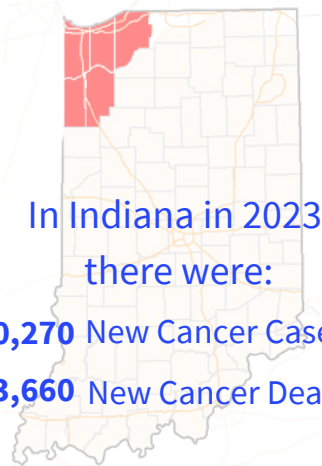


# Funding the Future: Northwest Indiana Impact

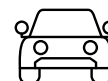

Since 1991, we have invested \$3.2 billion in cancer research contributing to 3.8 million fewer cancer deaths.

## Impact: Advocacy

The American Cancer Society Cancer Action Network (ACS CAN) is making cancer a top priority for public officials and candidates at the federal, state and local levels.



### 2023 Legislative Priorities

- Improve Access to Care
- Increase Tobacco Prevention & Cessation Funding



### Tobacco Prevention & Cessation

\$70 million is recommended for annual funding for tobacco prevention and cessation in Indiana. Currently, the Indiana General Assembly only provides \$5 million.
