



- In 2021, more than **281,500** women & **2,620** men are expected to be newly diagnosed with breast cancer in the US.
- Breast cancer is the most commonly diagnosed cancer in women in the US
- Breast cancer is the second-leading cause of cancer death in women
- Breast cancer death rates have declined 41% since 1989, leading to over 350,000 lives saved



UFT/NYSUT Team Incentives

To receive incentive items by walk day donations must be posted/ submitted two weeks prior to the event. Schools need to post donations online and submit to the American Cancer Society by **November 6, 2021** to be eligible for the incentive program.



UFT/NYSUT teams that raise over \$1000 or more online are eligible to receive a team banner or a plaque.


